

Motion 20120828_19: Move to substitute the current Welfare / Health Resolution regarding breeding stock requirements and advertising with the following resolution:

“Resolution: The Vizsla Club of America calls for ALL breeding stock to be radiographed, and specifies that no dog or bitch with the slightest evidence of hip dysplasia be used for breeding purposes. In keeping with this resolution, and in full support of the Vizsla Club of America Code of Ethics, which states that only those Vizslas that are over two years of age, X-Rayed, and OFA certified as free of hip dysplasia be bred the VCA agrees to accept the removal of OFA listing requirements in advertisements in all official VCA publications, with the exception of Stud Dog Listings, and litter announcements.”
